

TRAINEESHIPS

Course duration

- Between 10 weeks and 6 months
- You will attend your work placement for 4 days per week and attend classroom-based training for 1 day per week.

Entry requirements

- Must be aged between 16–18 years and officially left school
- Have legally lived in the UK for 3 years and, or a legal right as a resident of the UK at the start of their course.

What is a traineeship?

- Traineeships are pre-apprenticeship and employment courses that provide you with valuable work experience alongside developing your skills in English, maths and employability
- Placements are available with a wide range of employers, in different types of organisations and will provide you with a valuable experience in the workplace, to make an informed decision on your future career goals
- Programmes are a between 10 weeks and 6 months that can enhance and develop the confidence and skills you need to progress onto an apprenticeship, full time employment or further education.

What else is involved?

- Functional Skills in English and maths up to level 2 or GCSE
- Prevent strategy
- British Values level 1
- Mental health and well-being level 1
- Keeping safe and healthy level 1.
- Visits from external agencies
- Gain experience and learn practical work skills
- Smaller class sizes
- Full preparation for the world of work
- Short course that leads to fantastic opportunities
- Course content based on individual needs.

On successful completion of the traineeship you will have gained invaluable skills and experience in order to be successful in the next stage of your chosen career path.
